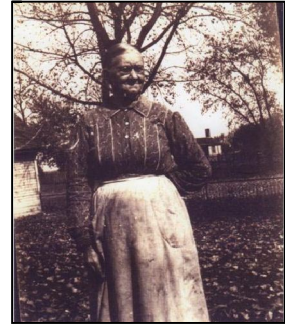

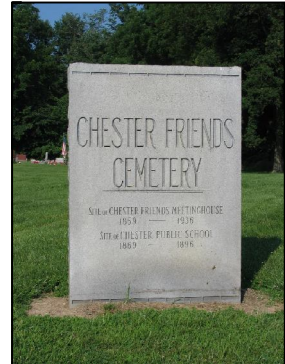

Conclusion (30 Dec 2018): Although there is no primary evidence, the secondary records do indicate that Keziah Tomlinson, ID0070 was born in Feb 1852 in Hamilton County, Indiana. The most compelling source for the date of birth is the 1900 US Census [7]. Hamilton County, Indiana being the birthplace is only supported by secondary sources. Being born in Indiana, however, is supported by all of the census records.

Conclusion (30 Dec 2018): The evidence, excluding [5] [6] [7] and [10] confirm that Milton Tomlinson and Delilah Hiatt were the parents of Keziah Tomlinson. The birthplaces of the parents are also correct as North Carolina for Milton Tomlinson and Indiana for Delilah Hiatt. The birthplaces given in the 1860 and 1870 census were probably provided by either Milton or Delilah and the 1880 through 1920 Census was probably provided by Keziah, which either way, the information would be very close to the source.

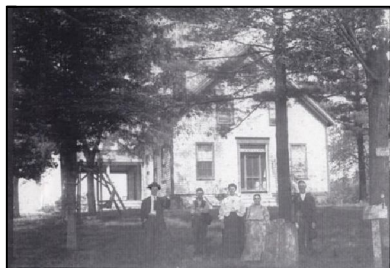

The names are spelled incorrectly in this source but it is obvious who it is and that the clerk simply spelled the names wrong on the form. The other exact date is from an authored source [4]. The 1900 Census confirms the year of 1873 [3].
