**HOW WILL THESE REGULATIONS EFFECT YOU?**

The following information should help the tank owner or operator to protect health and the environment. The exhibits attached will answer the question, "What do I have to do", minimum requirements, and "When do I have to act", deadlines.

The following are the major points of the UST regulation:

- . If you install a UST after December 1988, it must meet the requirements for new UST's concerning correct installation, leak detection, corrosion protection, and spill/overflow prevention. (See Exhibits A and B - New Tank Boxes)
- . If you have a UST that was installed before December 1988, it must meet two major requirements:
  - .. Requirements for leak detection. (See Exhibits A and B - Existing Tank Boxes)
  - .. Requirements for corrosion protection and spill/overflow prevention. (See Exhibits A and B - Existing Tank Boxes)
- . You must take corrective action in response to leaks. (See Exhibit C)
- . You must follow closure requirements for tanks you temporarily or permanently close. (See Exhibit D)



- . You are financially responsible for the cost of cleaning up a leak and compensating other people for bodily injury and property damage caused by the leak. (See Exhibit E)
