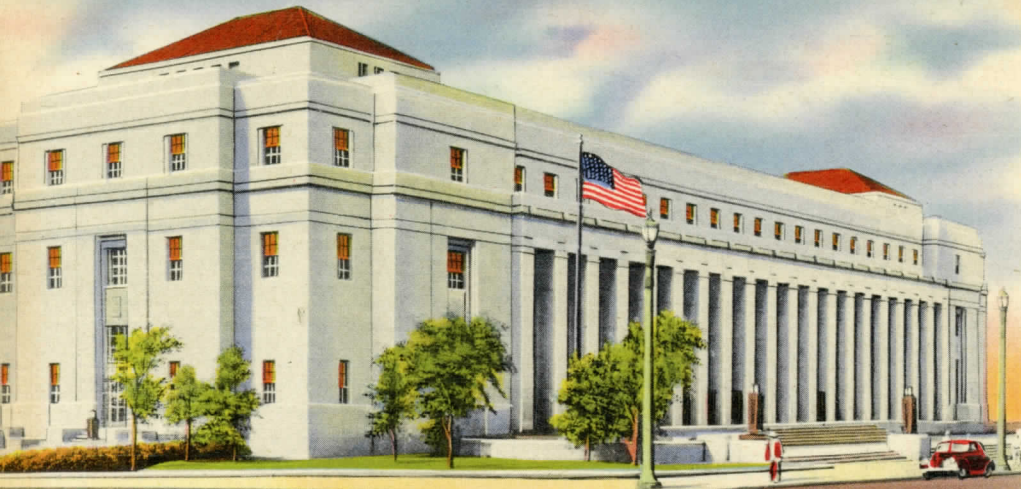


U. S. Post Office, St. Louis, Missouri

Station.

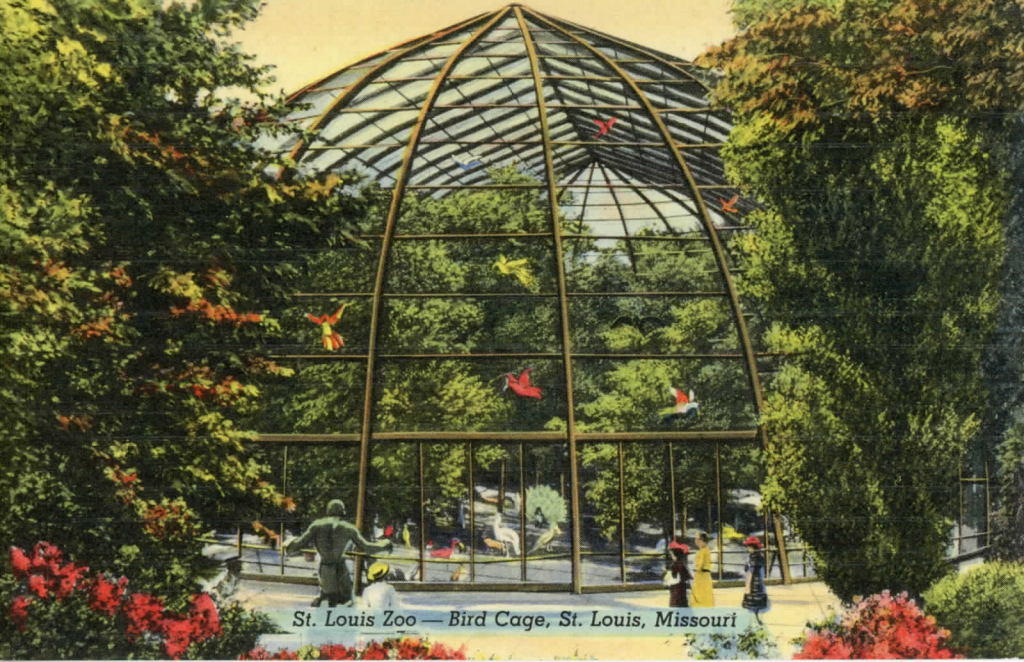

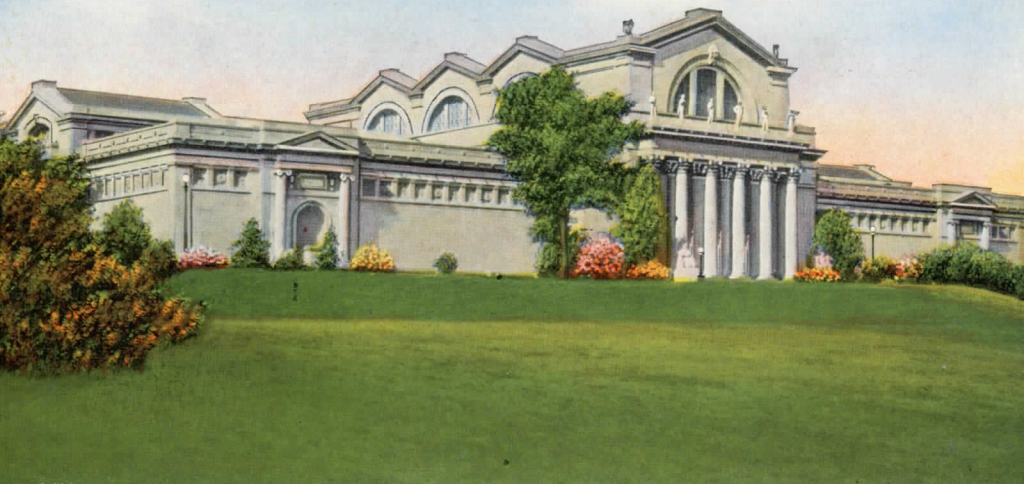
