Do you have any idea as to who is the father of 1765 Peter? Lois makes it sound like Christian is his father but I don't have a list of Christian's children, do you? I need to look through all the information Harold Winchester sent me, I might be able to discover something in there that I have forgotten.

I hope John is still improving and that all is going well with both of you.

Our weather is terrible, instead of our nice clean air coming in from the ocean we are having an off-shore wind and getting 100 degree heat and smog from the east bay. I have never seen such dirty air here. They use a scale 0-50 good, 51-100 moderate and 101-200 bad. Yesterday the temp. was 98 and air quality 92. Today the temp. got up to 101 and don't know yet what the air quality is being called. But I know it is bad, I can't walk and breathe at the same time outside. The only yard work I can do is water either early in the morning or late in the evening, everything else is going to have to wait for better weather. Other than the weather everything is going well. I still have aches and pains but just have to know when to quit.
