Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Williams of the County of Delaware and State of Indiana for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge by Thomas L. Poor of the County and State aforesaid have bargained and sold and confirmed unto the said Thomas L. Poor his heirs and assigns forever all the following real estate to-wit: The east half of the South east quarter and the South west quarter of the South east quarter of Section No Eleven in Township Twenty Two North of Range No ten East in the County of Delaware and State of Indiana. Supposed to contain one hundred and twenty acres more or less. To have and to hold the same with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging, free from all encumbrances unto the said Thomas L. Poor his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Williams doth covenant with the said Thomas L. Poor his heirs and assigns, that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid and has good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same and that he will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said Thomas L. Poor his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of July A.D. 1853
