

Delaware County's Delinquent Taxpayers of 1847

The Following names were published on pages one, two and three of the *Indiana Signal* on 13 December 1848 with the heading: "A LIST OF LANDS & LOTS in Delaware County, Returned Delinquent for non-payment of Taxes Thereon for the Year 1847". The owners' names, number of acres, township, exact location of land, amount of taxes owed and other information were published. Some landowners held land in more than one township. Joseph Anthony was the county auditor. He gave notice that the lands and lots would be sold at public auction to pay for the taxes, interest and penalties owed. The sale would be held on the first Monday, being the first day of January 1849. Those not sold would be forfeited to the state.
