Administrator's Bond.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT We *John G. Stough*
John Moderwell & *James M. Crack* are held and firmly bound unto

THE STATE OF OHIO in the penal sum of *eight hundred dollars*
current Money of the United States, for the payment

of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally; as witness our
hands and SEALS, this *9th* day of *July* A.D. 1835-

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bound *John G. Stough*
do make or cause to be made a true inventory

of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights and credits of *Peter Whitstone*
deceased, which have or shall come into *his* possession or knowledge; or possession
of any other person or persons for *him* and make return thereof to the Clerk of the
Court of Common Pleas in his office, within three months from the date thereof, and
the same goods, chattels, rights and credits, and all other goods, chattels, rights and
credits of the said deceased, at the time of his death which shall come into *his* possession
or the possession of any other persons for *him* do well and truly
administer according to law; and further, do make a true and full account of *his* admin-
istration within twelve months, and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels,
rights and credits which shall be found remaining upon the Administrator's account, the
same being first examined and approved of by the Court, shall deliver and pay to such
person or persons respectively as the Court, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of
the law, shall direct, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament,
was made by the said deceased, and the executor, executors, executrix or executrices
therein named, shall prove the same according to law, and obtain letters testamentary
thereon, if the within bounded *John G. Stough*

on being by the Court required, do deliver up the said
letters of administration, then this obligation to be void and of none effect; otherwise
remain in full force and virtue.
