The Brown family came to Indiana from Warren County, Ohio, in the spring of 1877. They lived near Westfield, where Wade Furnas now lives, for a time, and then moved near Deming, on the farm well known as the Jesse Foulke farm, where they lived for about ten years. Later the family lived on what was known as the Isaac Stanton place, west of Carmel. Mrs. Brown, their mother, the widow of Samuel Brown, still makes her home at Carmel.
