

Dwelling House Burned.

The four-room dwelling house of Mrs. Lydia Parson, near Carson's Corner, nine miles northwest of this city, together with nearly all the contents, was totally destroyed by fire Monday evening. The flames originated from an overheated stove due to irregular gas pressure. Mrs. Parson who is teaching school at West Grove, and her children, were absent from home at the time. The loss will amount to nearly \$500, with no insurance.

Sunday a smoke house, belonging to **George Foulke**, near Deming, was burned to the ground. A large quantity of meat and lard was destroyed.
