The tract was located in Fredericksburg Twp., Craven Co., South Carolina, (now Kershaw Co.) on the north side of the Wateree River. Josiah Tomlinson was a Friend of Quaker. He may be the same Josiah Tomlinson who received a removal certificate from the Friends Monthly Meeting in Dublin, Ireland on the 8th. of 2nd.month 1751. There was a Josiah Tomlinson living near either Timahoe or Edenderry, County Kildare, Ireland before 1751. Timahoe was within the bounds of Dublin Monthly Meeting. Sara R.
