The earliest record of Josiah Tomlinson in America is the precept for a land grant in South Carolina which he received from Gov. George Hunter of South Carolina on Oct. 25, 1751. A tract of land of 450 acres was surveyed for him on Mar. 11, 1752. The tract was located in Fredericksburg Twp., Craven Co., South Carolina, (now Kershaw Co.) on the north side of the Wateree River. Josiah Tomlinson was a Friend of Quaker. He may be the same Josiah Tomlinson who received a removal certificate from the Friends Monthly Meeting in Dublin, Ireland on the 8th. of 2nd. month 1751. There was a Josiah Tomlinson living near either Timahoe or Edenderry, County Kildare, Ireland before 1751. Timahoe was within the bounds of Dublin Monthly Meeting. Sara R. Haworth, in her book Springfield, 1773-1940... claims that Josiah Tomlinson arrived on the ship Hitchcock from Whitehaven, England.
