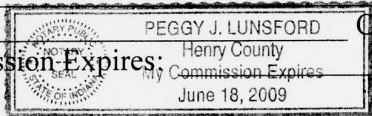




4. That the probable value of the Decedent's probate estate is less than \$25,000, wherein the Petitioner is merely requesting probating the Will and Spreading the Same of
