JAMES MONROE, President of the United States of America,
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know ye, That *Peter Whetstone, of Stark*
County, Ohio,

having deposited in the **General Land Office**, a Certificate of the Register of the **Land Office** at *Steubenville* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for *The South East-quarter, of section nine, in township Seventeen, of range Six, containing One hundred and fifty five acres, & fifty five hundredths of an acre,*

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Steubenville* by the Act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the **Ohio**, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted**, by the United States, unto the said

Peter Whetstone the *quarter* lot or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *Peter Whetstone,* *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made **Patent**, and the seal of the **General Land-Office** to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of **Washington**, the *twenty eighth* day of *March* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *twenty* and of the Independence of the United States of America, the forty fourth.
