John and Louan had made a gallant fight, indeed, but they were largely outnumbered and began to despair, but Joseph Baker's [page 259] appearance gave them new courage and they were again ready for the fight. Owen Williams and Jesse Baker soon spread the news, and it was not long until people from Deming and Westfield heard of this attempted arrest and were upon the scene."
