Also to note, if the Williams County marriage records, Caroline Whetstone and Henry Hause. I am sure you have seen it spelled that way before.

On to my family line. Andrew and Catherine are my GG Grandparents. Andrew J. Schlosser was born Jan 16, 1830 in PA and died Feb 27, 1893 in Williams County. Catherine Guilingner (you will see it spelled several different ways) was born Nov 10, 1835 in Mercer County, PA and died June 6, 1907 in Williams County. They are buried in Buck Creek Cemetery. It is a remote cemetery and many of the stones there have been vandalized. They had ten children. Three died as infants or toddlers. Two of the boys married the Whetstone sisters, and my great grandmother was the youngest.

I am more than happy to help. I do not live in Ohio anymore, but do have many of the Williams County and Defiance County record books if you need a look up. I don't have them all, but am glad to see if I do.
